Open to referrals and self-referrals. Runs three times a year in-person and online. Topics include:

- Consent
- Moving Forward

Schools Offer

Free awareness talks and training aimed to educate students and improve community response to domestic abuse and ensure earlier intervention and signposting of victims to specialist services. Topics include:
