MELLOW PARENTS (MOTHERS)

A 14-week group intervention, to promote secure attachments that aid a child's development. The intervention also explores a parents' own experience of being parented and the importance of parental mental health. This group is open to mothers of children aged 0-3, with children attending sessions alongside their mothers.
