JOB TITLE: Sessional Chlamydia Screening Assistant

JOB PURPOSE

1. Offer young people aged 15–24 the opportunity to take self-administered chlamydia tests in a variety of non-clinical settings.

- 2. Provide young people with clear, accurate information about chlamydia, STI testing and other sexual health issues in a sensitive and non-judgmental manner.
- 3. Ensure clients are given the opportunity to feed back about the quality of the service provided.
- 4. Keep clear, accurate, confidential written records of client information as required.
- 5. Maintain client confidentiality at all times.
- 6. Maintain professional relationships with colleagues, outreach venue staff and clients.
- 7. Provide regular, accurate feedback to the Youth Engagement Officers.
- 8. Maintain excellent communication and reliability by contacting colleagues to arrange logistics of a shift beforehand, by starting and finishing shifts on time and by returning client information to the agreed office in a timely manner.
- 9. Perform other required duties in line with the terms and conditions of the post as negotiated with the Youth Engagement Officers.
