

Invitation to tender – BedZed Pavilion

Peabody Community Foundation are seeking organisations wishing to operate a service from BedZed Pavilion, a community facility in the London Borough Sutton. The community centre is situated on a zero-energy development.

BedZed Pavilion is a community facility located on a zero energy development, which overlooks a wild-life meadow. It is also a short walk away from Hackbridge train station.

The venue has:

- A fully functional commercial kitchen
- Café space
- Two tier open mezzanine
- Two small rooms perfect for office space or small activities.

Peabody has a commitment to supporting the needs of the local community and there are currently a range of community focused groups using the space, and activities taking place in the building. The new partner will need to commit to continuing to support these activities and other relevant programmes that develop.

However, the building also presents an opportunity for an organisation to increase use of the space through hiring to other organisations, or to utilise the space for their own programmes or activities alongside the community offer.
