- You are welcome to leave leaflets/fliers advertising your organisation by your tree. If you choose to leave a donations box, we are unable to take responsibility for this and you do so at your own risk.
- Please avoid using any food items on the trees.

The trees can be decorated in a way that reflects your community group/school/business- therefore a chance to let your imagination run wild!
