Summer Art Workshops with Zoe Akroyd Parker

FAB Croydon is collaborating with Zoe Akroyd Parker to offer increased access to arts activities over the summer holidays. Zoe is a qualified arts teacher with over 20 years of experience (including extensive experience with children with a range of challenges). She holds an enhanced DBS certificate. Her workshop formats are tried and tested and have received extremely positive feedback from many adults and children in Croydon.

Proposal

We would like to offer a number of fully funded places (normal price is £15) for children who would not otherwise be able to attend. The places will be within existing workshops to be held at Elizabeth James Gallery (10 Portland Rd, South Norwood SE25 4PF) or Matthews Yard (1 Matthews Yard, Off Surrey Street, Croydon, CR0 1FF). This enables any referred young people a range of date options and the opportunity to mix socially with others. Places would be on a first come, first served (average of 4 funded spaces for each workshop) and all materials will be provided. There are two formats:

Chalk/Charcoal/Pastel for Ages 8 to 16
Lino Cutting for Ages 10 to 16
